## membership rules



Adopted by a resolution of the Trustees on July 29th 2004, (to supercede the rules first adopted by a resolution of the Trustees on October 12th 2000), in accordance with Article 22 of the ICA:UK Memorandum & Articles of Association, with immediate effect.

Should any inconsistencies be found, nothing in these bye laws shall repeal or affect anything contained in the Memorandum & Articles of Association.

### **Subscriptions**

- 1. Individuals and families wishing to support and stay informed of the work of ICA:UK are welcome to join the ICA:UK Network as 'Supporters' by paying an annual subscription.
- 2. New subscriptions shall be valid for one year from the first day of the month in which they were received. Subscription renewals (received within one year after expiry) shall be valid for one year from the date of expiry.
- 3. The annual subscription payable will be £20 for families, £15 for individuals, or £7.50/£5 for concessions.
- 4. Supporters will be included in the ICA:UK Network contact list, receive the newsletter 'ICA:UK Network News' and be invited to join the ICA:UK Network yahoogroup. They will also be invited to become further involved in ICA:UK's work as members (see below), trustees, and/or programme associates and participants.
- 5. Honorary annual subscriptions may be awarded to representatives of key partner organisations of ICA:UK for example those of ICA:UK's International Programme and sister members of ICA International.
- 6. Up to two written subscription reminders may be sent before Supporters whose subscriptions have expired are excluded from the ICA:UK Network contact list. Supporters, however, remain responsible themselves for keeping their own subscriptions up to date.

#### **Memberships**

- Supporters only are invited to become members of ICA:UK, with the rights and obligations
  of members as laid out the Memorandum & Articles of Association, by completing an
  ICA:UK membership form. Members' rights include the right to attend and vote at the
  Annual General Meeting, and so to elect ICA:UK's trustees and officers. The liability of
  members is limited to £10 in the event that the company be wound up and its liabilities
  exceed its assets.
- 2. Membership shall be subject to the formal acceptance of the trustees (ref. Article 2). In the event that an application for membership be denied, the trustees shall minute the reasoning behind their decision and the applicant may appeal to a General Meeting.
- 3. In the case of family subscriptions, membership rights and obligations shall pertain to up to two adult family members only.
- 4. Membership of ICA:UK, and its related rights and obligations, shall expire when the member's annual subscription expires.
- 5. In the event that the trustees resolve to terminate a membership, they shall minute the reasoning behind their decision and it must be ratified by a General Meeting in order to take effect.
- 6. Provided that the number of members never fall below two (ref. Article 2), the trustees shall accept a member's written resignation, with effect from their formal acceptance.
